- **General Contractor Member (GC) is defined as** an individual, partnership, corporation, or other business entity that is capable of performing construction work as a contractor with overall responsibility for the satisfactory completion of a project using its own forces to perform or supervise part of the work AND which performs 25% of its total volume of work as a general contractor. Contractors with multi-state operations or majority ownership in multiple general construction companies within the chapter should call for more information about AGC of America dues policies.
- **Chapter Investment:** Dues are based upon the volume of work performed by the member within chapter territory during the previous calendar year.
- **AGC of America Investment:** Dues for general contractor members in their initial year of membership are \$475, regardless of volume of work performed. For subsequent years, AGC of America dues are calculated based on volume of work performed. See below.

- **Specialty Contractor Member (SC) is defined as** any individual or firm who cannot qualify for membership as a general contractor member, but who performs a portion of the work on a construction site and has not undertaken a volume of work as a “general contractor” that amounts to more than 25% of their total volume of business measured over the two preceding calendar years.
- **AGC of America Investment:** Annual AGCA dues for specialty contractor members are \$160, regardless of volume of work performed.

The AGC membership year begins July 1 and ends June 30 of the subsequent year.
